When are we going to eat? Jaajana\`gi hi\`warucikjanawi?

What was your favorite present? Waz`a\wooga nee has`i\ni\`na, jaagu hiraicera raipixji\`?

(Waz`a\wooga nee has`i\ni\`na, hacjijana`ka hiraicera raipixji?)

Do you want to go play outside? Ca\`a\`geja ras`gac rooragu\`?

Let's (you and I) go play outside. Ca\`a\`geja hi\`s`gac howinekje.

(Ca`ageja hišgac hi`nekje.)

Let's (we, including you) go play outside. Ca\`a\`geja hi\`s`gac howi\`nekjanawi.

(Ca`ageja hišgac hi`nekjawi)

How does it look like outside? Ca\`a\`geja horog`ocra jaasge?

(Or Ca`ageja jaasge jee? – How is it outside?)

What do you want to do today? Ha\apte'e jaagu s`u\ rooragu?

Let's (you and I) read a book. Waagax hakiruxara hiz`a\ hu\urog`oc.

(Waagax hakiruxara hiz`a\ hu\urog`ocikje.)

The Christmas tree looks pretty! Ma\ani\kisak na\`a\ horog`ocra waxja!

Turn the lights on. Hataz`ara hija hi`u\ne.

It looks nice out today. Ha\apte'e horog`ocra ma\ap\ihije.

Are you going to help cook? Waruc `u\una ragijis`erekjene?

Did you like all of your gifts? Waz`a\wooga has`i\ni\na hanaac raipi\lxi\?

It's time to eat. Warucra herena.

I am very full. Wa`ina\c haki\. (I made myself full)

What did you cook? Jaaguiz`a\ waruc s`u\?

It has been a fun day. Ha\apra waxja hi\russ`a\na\. (for myself) (I had fun today)

I'm glad to see you today. Ha\apte'e hani\cara haipi\.

Take some food with you. Warucra hisge wani\ s`ere,

(Warucra hisge hakja hašinj rakarana. – You can take some food back with you)

Put your coat and boots on. Woonaz`i\ na\ga waguje has`i\ni\na
howag`ukre.

(Woonaz`i hašinjina howağuk anaga waguje hašinjina woojane!)

or

(Woonaz`i hokawağuk anaga waguje wookarajane!)
